Guidance and support from experienced trainers.

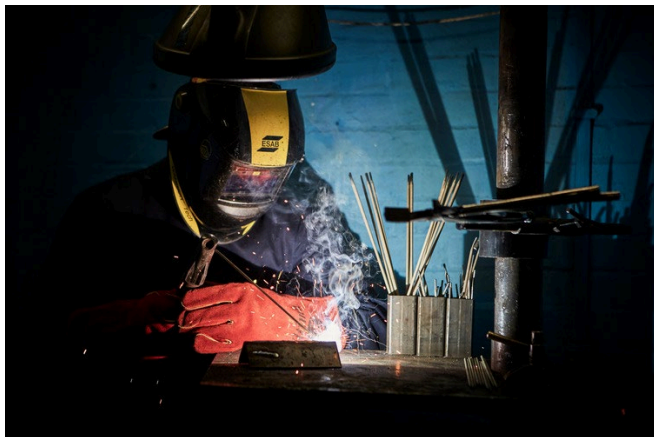

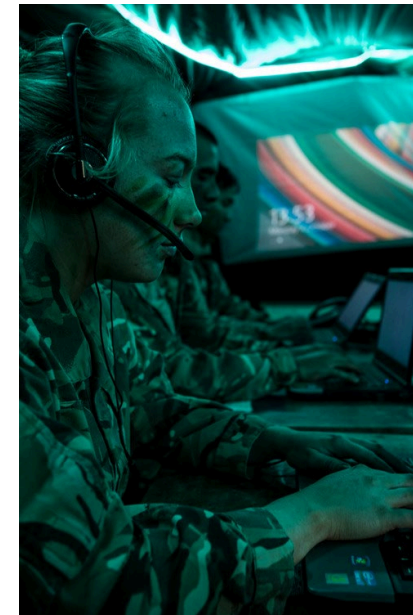
